Assignment- create an image using multiple layers, use at least 2 adjustment layers and make a clipping path

Class 4 Illustrator basics- tools

Assignment- create an image using tools learned

Class 5 pen tool, text effects

Assignment- create a logo for a resale shop or restaurant

Class 6 text effects continued, outlines, importing images, layers, effects

Assignment- create a poster using text, graphics and placed image

Class 7 building graphics from template, multiple windows, preview and outline

Assignment- create an image using the supplied image as a template

Class 8 gradient mesh, combining paths, clipping mask, opacity mask

Assignment- create a self promotion logo

Class 9 InDesign basics- tools, placing text and image

Assignment- create a poster using text and image

Class 10 master page, page layout, and packaging
