### Excursion to Kutna Hora

- Meet guide and board coach for your day excursion to Kutna Hora (approximately 1 hour)

**City Tour:** Thanks to the prosperous silver mines, Kutna Hora became the second most important town of the Kingdom of Bohemia on the Middle ages. There are many unique Gothic monuments in this town, especially St. Barbara's Cathedral (1388–1565), one of the most beautiful structures of the Czech Gothic, then Italian Court with Royal mint, where the famous Prague groschens were coined, Stone House, Church of St. James, etc. At nearby Sedlec, it is possible to visit the Ossuary, Kutna hora is on the UNESCO list of World Cultural and Natural Heritage (entrances included to St. Barbora Church, Italian Court, and Sedlec Ossuary)

- Break for lunch (on own) during your tour.
- After tour, return to your hotel in Prague.
- In the evening, meet your guide and walk/take public transportation to a traditional Czech restaurant for dinner & a [black light theater performance](#)!



## June 9

### Prague: Sightseeing & Immersion

- Meet guide for a full day (6-hours) of sightseeing via public transportation!

**Old Town Square & Prague Jewish Ghetto:** Visit the Jewish quarter in Prague which represents the best preserved complex of Jewish relics in Europe. It was found in the 13th century. Make your way to Old Town Square, the most important square of historical Prague (entrances included)

- Stop provided for lunch on your own today

**Museum of Communism:** This museum presents a vivid account of Communism focusing on Czechoslovakia in general and on Prague in particular. A variety of fields are represented including: daily life, politics, history, sport, economics, education, "the arts", media propaganda, the Peoples' Militias, the secret police, censorship, judiciary and coercive institutions (including the Stalinist show-trials), and political labor camps. It is the first and only museum in Prague (since the Velvet Revolution) exclusively devoted to a system established in the sphere of the former Soviet Union. Opened in 2001, the original items and installations containing authentic artifacts are displayed in the three main rooms of the Museum and conveniently follow the themes of: Communism The Dream, The Reality and The Nightmare. There is also a projection room with regular short film screenings (entrances included)

- After tour, return to your hotel. Enjoy a free evening.

### Prague: Sightseeing & Immersion

- Meet guide for a half day of sightseeing via public transportation.

**Prague Castle Tour & Charles Bridge:** The tour begins by visiting the **Prague Castle**, a national monument and the symbol of the Czech state for centuries. Since its foundation in the last quarter of the 9th century it has been developing uninterruptedly throughout the past 11 centuries. It is a monumental complex containing religious, military, and residential structures. After castle tour, continue to Charles Bridge. The oldest bridge in Prague, it was founded in 1357 by Charles IV and completed by Petr Parler in 1402. The bridge is fortified with two towers on both bridgeheads (entrances to Prague Castle included).

- After tour, return to your hotel and spend the rest of the afternoon at your leisure.

The town's riverside spa district is home to several columned walkways and natural springs. There are 12 springs, the most famous of which is the Vridlo. Highlights of this tour include visit to Moser Crystal factory (entrances included)
