

Parking will be limited on campus. Students should bring all belongings downstairs before bringing a car to campus for loading.

Students do not need to remove all belongings, only what they will need through mid-April. Students should dispose of perishable items, trash, and recycling before departure.

Residence Life staff will be conducting a building inspection after March 22. Any perishable items left out, or trash that could attract pests or cause odor will be disposed of. Students will be notified, via UArts email, of any items disposed of from their apartment.

By what date do I need to collect my priority items?

March 22 is the date that residence halls will close. For those residents returning to campus to collect priority items in the coming days they will find their residence hall open, Public Safety present, and that sign in procedures are the same as during other times of the year.

Who can I speak with if I am uncertain where I should go when I leave campus?

Should I move out my furniture?

Tips:

Travel

- Work with your support network (family, friends, mentors) to determine your next steps and destination

- Dispose of any perishable items, take out trash and recycling.
