The Photography Program in the School of Art at the University of the Arts is pleased to announce a Call for Entry for our Spring 2024 Juried Photo Exhibition, *A Sense of Place*. Celebrating the creativity of regional high school students, we invite applicants to submit lens-based work that expresses their interpretations of community, personal sanctuary, and home. Selected photographs will be showcased in the Photography Program Gallery, located in Center City, Philadelphia from April 13 - May 4. We invite all applicants and their loved ones to attend an opening reception on April 13th from 2-4pm on the 15th floor of Terra Hall, located at 211 S Broad St.

Students are to submit up to three individual entries [here](#), along with a completed permission form with parental/guardian consent for those under the age of 18.

After the selection process, students have the option to mail/drop off their work at the university. For students who do not have access to printing facilities or who are unable to deliver/mail their printed photographs to the university, the Photography Program will provide free inkjet printing. Students may pick up their work on May 4th from 9am-2pm.

Eligible winners will receive scholarship awards to study in our 2024 Pre-College Summer Institute Art, Media & Design program; award amounts go up to the full cost of tuition. Senior students will be eligible for alternate prizes.
